3. **Political Declaration** on HIV/AIDS: Intensifying our Efforts to Eliminate HIV/AIDS

- Recommit to 2006 **Political Declaration** and 2001 **Declaration of Commitment**
- New global **targets** for 2015
- Mobilize **funding** (US \$22-24 billion per year)
- Shared **responsibility**
- Universal **access**
- Key **populations**
- **Trade Related Aspects of Intellectual Property (TRIPS)** principles
- UNAIDS **Strategy 2011-2015**

4. Bold new targets for 2015

- 50% ↓ in sexual transmission of HIV
- 50% ↓ of HIV among people who inject drugs
- 50% ↓ TB deaths in people living with HIV
- Ensure no children are born with HIV and reduction of AIDS-related maternal deaths
- 15 million on antiretroviral treatment



5. The Way Forward

Building on the Declaration, now important for countries to:

- Adhere to the **commitments** and put **strategies** in place to reach targets
- Increase **investments**—both domestic and donor
- Monitor **progress**, **identify** weaknesses and **close** gaps
