What is Naz Foundation International (NFI)?

Naz Foundation International has been providing technical and institutional assistance to MSM networks, groups, collectives and organisations in South Asia since 1996 to develop their own HIV prevention, care and support services through community based organising.

Resource and Information Centre

The NFI Resource and Information Centre was established in the year 2000 in our Regional Liaison Office, based in Lucknow, India. Currently the Centre contains over 3500 books, documents, manuals, articles, reports, international journals, toolkits, data cds, proceedings of conferences and symposiums primarily focusing on male sexualities, gender, HIV and AIDS, human rights and law. Along with these documents and books, we also host an electronic library of some 1500 documents in pdf, powerpoint and microsoft formats.

All important Indian newspapers and magazine cuttings of related news or articles are also available for reference purposes.

Objective

The objective of the Resource Centre is a growing knowledge management base with a specific focus on male-male sexualities, sexual health and well-being.

This resource is a useful addition to the services that NFI offers nationally and internationally, providing a significant tool to enable those conducting research on these issues, those who are just interested in learning more, as well as those who want to improve the quality of their own HIV service organisations working with males who have sex with males (MSM).

Database
